

OUTLINE FOR MEAL SERVICE ON ALC/CRC

Updated February 2nd, 2017

It will be the responsibility of Food Services to serve the meal to the correct patient. Food Services knows the diets, therefore they are responsible for what the patient is fed based on their Meditech reports.

It will be the responsibility of nursing to be present in the dining room during meals (lunch and supper), to observe patients as they eat. A nurse from CRC and a nurse from ALC will be present at these times and should not be sitting out of sight of the patients (i.e. sitting by the windows).

It will also be the responsibility of nursing to open packages, assist with feeding, cut up meals, thicken drinks, etc.

It will be the responsibility of the cook to serve patients being served in their rooms and puree diets before any other patients are fed. Nursing will deliver the trays to patients that are eating in their rooms.

Clean up will be the responsibility of food services, but nursing has agreed to help should they have time.
